Dairy Cattle Lameness Residential Course

9th – 11th September 2009
University of Bristol, Langford

This **FREE** course aims to increase awareness of the economic and welfare implications of lameness and to provide up to date information on methods of monitoring and preventing. It is aimed at veterinary students in early clinical years and agricultural students entering their final year.

Students will participate in classroom and practical sessions along side agricultural and veterinary students from other institutions. Following field visits to dairy farms in the area students will work in teams to review the main lameness issues present on the farms and identify the causes and possible solutions.

Students will also be encouraged produce a presentation to be given to their fellow students on return to university or college
